Whites

Mariquita

Sauvignon Blanc · Valle Central, Chile

This wine shows a bright yellow-green colour. The nose is elegant with dominant notes of flower exquisitely mixed with herbal tones. In mouth, the wine is crisp, fresh round and well balanced with a long finish. We especially recommend that you enjoy it as an aperitif or matched with fresh seafood.

Aroha Bay (ve)

Sauvignon Blanc · Marlborough, New Zealand

The elegant Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc is alive with aromas of stone-fruit and minerals with flavours of guava and lime. One sip and you're up, up and away!

Bushranger (ve)

Chardonnay · Warburn Estates, South East Australia

This wine shows typical passion fruit and melon characteristics, cleverly balanced with fresh unwooded Chardonnay to add peach and lime notes on the palate.

Pinot Grigio · Pavia, Italy

A fresh, dry white with gentle floral and citrus aromas. Crisp and delicate on the palate with lightly honeyed fruit balanced by lemony acidity and a fresh, dry finish.

Jaffelin

Chardonnay · Vin du France

80% of the Chardonnay come from Pays d'Oc for the roundness and the exotic fruits; and 20% from Burgundy for the minerality and floral notes of the Chardonnay. The wine is vinified in stainless steel tanks and no oak is involved in order to keep the freshness of the ripe Chardonnay grapes.

Domaine de La Motte

Chablis · Burgundy, France

A classic Chablis from vines grown on the famous Kimmeridgian Clay. Pale straw with green glints. Fruity and floral on the nose with citrus notes. On the palate the wine is fresh and beautifully balanced, with good ripe fruit and a long, exquisite mineral finish.

Sancerre 'Les Fondettes'

Sauvignon · Loire, France

Slow, cool fermentation with skin contact and some of the best sites in the region help to produce a Sancerre of intensity with rich mineral flavours and a long subtle finish.

Cloudy Bay

Sauvignon Blanc · New Zealand

Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc set the world alight when it first hit the market in the mid 1980's with its vibrant gooseberry flavours and unmistakable varietal character. Today, the wine virtually sells out before it arrives! Scented and summery, Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc has deliciously vibrant aromatics that infuse the tropical fragrance of pineapples with garden-fresh basil and the spiciness of crushed tomato leaves. The palate is long and succulent, combining fruits with ripe, red capsicum and a twist of green olive, beautifully complemented by crisp natural acidity and a hint of lime zest.

Mariquita

Merlot · Valle Central, Chile

This classic Merlot from the Valle Central is elegant and rich with aromas of chocolate, cherry and mocha. Ripe, rich fruit flavours of cherry and plum combine with warm spiciness that will go very well with grilled, roast beef and cheese dishes.

Bushranger (ve)

Shiraz · Warburn Estates,
South East Australia

Medium bodied and soft with easy drinking, spicy raspberry flavours. Soft and subtle vanilla tannins fill out the palate due to a touch of oak, which adds balance and sweet complexity to the finish.

La Vaca Gorda (ve)

Malbec · Argentina

Bright red-ruby. Aromas of blackberry, black raspberry, chocolate, nutty oak, fig and gunflint. Fine-grained and savory, with decent cut and a hint of smoke to the blackberry and currant flavors. This moderately complex, rather soft malbec finished with firm tannins, a note of nutty oak and a slight alcoholic warmth.

Trulli

Primitivo IGP · Puglia, Italy

Trulli Primitivo is a dark, red crimson colour. The nose displays aromas of dried fruits, white pepper, exotic spices and dark chocolate. It is round and intense in the mouth with layers on layers of soft, elegant tannin, vanilla, prunes, coffee and fruits of the forest. Fruity and rich with an elegant structure and a well-balance, lengthy finish.

Jaffelin

Pinot Noir · Vin du France

The influence of the southern climate gives this wine ripe and jammy nuances of dark fruits such as blackcurrant, blackberry and black cherry. 80% of the Pinot Noir come from Pays d'Oc for the colour, the roundness and the fruits; and 20% from the Loire for the minerality and acidity of the Pinot. The wine is vinified in stainless steel tanks and no oak is used in order to keep the freshness of the ripe Pinot Noir grapes.

Don Placero

Rioja Tinto · Spain

This is copybook soft, seductive un-oak Rioja, made from 60% Tempranillo grapes with 40% Garnacha, the classic native red varieties of Rioja. The wine exhibits sweet plum and raspberry fruit, finishing with cedar and vanilla on the palate.

Chateau Surain

Bordeaux (95% Merlot 5% Cabernet) · France

The Surain family have been mastering the art of wine at their family vineyard and winery for over four generations and they've made great things happen. This is an exceptional fresh and fruity wine.

Robinia

Pinot Grigio Rosé · Pavia, Italy

A dry, fresh and fruity rosé with delicate aromas of red berries. Crisp and lively on the palate with good intensity of ripe berry and red cherry fruit.

Zinfandel Rosé · USA

A delicate salmon-pink, medium wine that has been made using a very short maceration of the Zinfandel grapes after pressing.

Vispo Prosecco (ve)

Pale light yellow colour, delicate and complex bouquet with fruity notes reminiscent of peach and green apple, there are also good secondary notes of acacia and lilac. Fresh and light on the palate with balanced acidity.

Fiori di Campo Prosecco (ve)

NV Organic

Fiori Prosecco is produced from organically grown Glera grapes grown in the Valdobbiadene area around Treviso. This pale and delicate sparkling wine has fine bubbles and fresh aromas of green fruits, elderflower and honeysuckle. It is elegantly light, dry and well balanced.

Fiori di Bosco Rosato (ve)

NV Organic

A fresh and dry sparkling rosé with persistent white foam, beautifully cherry pink in colour. Red berry characters on the nose and palate make this soft and approachable in character. The grapes are sourced from the hills of the Adige and Vallagarina valleys in Trentio. Fiori is produced from organically grown grapes.

Nyetimber Cuvée (ve)

NV

Lovely pale gold and gentle, fine bubbles. Toasty, spicy and complex aromas showing wonderful development after more than three years on lees in our cellar. The palate supports these complex aromas with honey, almond, pastry and baked apple flavours. Very fine and elegant with a great combination of intensity, delicacy and length.

Nyetimber Rosé (ve)

NV

A beautiful, sunset pink colour. Aromas include a charming mix of fresh red fruits along with intriguing spice notes of anise and lavender. The palate has a creamy, round texture with refreshing redcurrant, raspberry and cherry flavours. Suggestions of brioche lead into an elegant, silky finish.
